**The Poultry Carcasses Importation
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1953.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, hereby order:—

1. The Poultry Carcasses Importation Ordinance, 1951 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) paragraph (d) of section two of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following paragraph substituted therefor—

“(d) an eviscerated carcase imported directly into this Island from and originating in such area of France and under such conditions as the Committee may from time to time by Order prescribe; or”;

(b) in subsection (1) of section four of the principal Ordinance there are hereby inserted immedi-

ately after the word "Ordinance" the words "or of any Order made thereunder";

(c) in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section four of the principal Ordinance immediately after the word "Ordinance" there are hereby inserted the words "or any Order made thereunder";

(d) in Part I of the Schedule to the principal Ordinance the word "Canada" is hereby deleted;

(e) in Part II of the Schedule to the principal Ordinance the word "Holland" is hereby deleted.

2. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Poultry Carcasses Importation Ordinances, 1951 and 1953.
