**The Prison Administration (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1988**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3 of the Prison Administration (Guernsey) Law, 1949, as amended(*a*), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of July, 1988, hereby order:—

1. The Prison Administration (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1959, as amended(*b*), is further amended as follows—

(*a*) in section 1 after the definition of “officer” insert—

““officer of police” means a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey and, within the limit of his jurisdiction, a member of the special constabulary of the Island of Guernsey.”;

(b) in section 1 after the definition of “the Panel” insert—

“ “States Revenue Officer” has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972;”(c);

(c) immediately after section 71(2) insert the following subsections—

“ (3) A States Revenue Officer may visit any prisoner on production of an authority issued by or on behalf of the Chief Revenue Officer.

(4) The Governor may, at the request of any prisoner allow him to be visited by a States Revenue Officer.”;

(d) section 93 is repealed.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Prison Administration (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1988.

(2) This Ordinance and the Prison Administration (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1959 to 1986 may be cited together as the Prison Administration (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1959 to 1988.
