ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 6th April, 1983
Coming into force 6th April, 1983

THE PROHIBITED PLACES (DOGS) (ALDERNEY)
ORDINANCE, 1983

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the fifth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight and the sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighty-three, hereby order:-

Prohibition on dogs straying or fouling certain places.

1.(1) The owner of a dog shall not permit that dog to be on any of the streets or places, including the footpaths adjacent to such streets or places, set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the prohibited places") otherwise than in his charge or in charge of another person.

(2) A person being in charge of a dog on any of the prohibited places shall at all times keep that dog on a lead.

(3) A person being in charge of a dog shall not permit that dog to foul any of the prohibited places by depositing its excrement thereon or urinating thereon.

Offences.

2. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of section one of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds.

Interpretation.

3.(1) In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression "owner", in relation to a dog, means the person to whom a licence in respect of the keeping thereof has been issued in accordance with the provisions of the Dog Licences (Guernsey) Law,

1969(a), as extended by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Dog Licences) Ordinance, 1969(b).

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(c), shall apply to the interpretation of this Law as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

(3) Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited Places (Dogs) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1983.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.
