**The Prohibited Places (Dogs)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1982**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and of the twenty-eighth day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited Places (Dogs) Ordinance, 1970 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a), is hereby amended as follows:— Amend-
ments to
Ordinance
of 1970.

- (a) in section two thereof the words “ten pounds” are repealed and the words “twenty pounds” are substituted therefor;
- (b) immediately after paragraph 5 of the Schedule thereto there is inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered “6” and “7”—

(a) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XVI, p. 450.

“6. Burnt Lane, Back Street, Port Vase, Les Corbins Lane, Les Corbins Steps, Bruce Lane (Upper Canichers) and Water Lanes, Saint Peter Port.

7. Les Canichers, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Saint Julian's Avenue to its junction with Bosq Lane.”.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited Places (Dogs) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982.

Collective title.

3. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Prohibited Places (Dogs) Ordinances, 1970 and 1982.
