The Prohibition of Sunday Games (Repeal) Ordinance, 1971

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. (1) In the Ordinance passed at the Chief Pleas after Michaelmas, fifteen hundred and sixty-six^(a), the words “Que nuls jeux ne se feront au Dymenche durant les sermons et services, sur peine de dix souls d’amende, maynty à la Roigne et maynty au trouveur” are hereby repealed. Repeals.

(2) Paragraph 24 of the Ordinance passed at the Chief Pleas after Michaelmas, fifteen hundred and eighty-one^(b), is hereby repealed.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibition of Sunday Games (Repeal) Ordinance, 1971. Citation.
