## Ordinance of the States **XVI** 1985

### **The Protection of Pigeons (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 15th day of March, 1985, hereby order:—

1. In section 1 of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance pour la Protection des Pigeons” of the 21st October, 1933<sup>(a)</sup>— Amendments to Ordinance of 1933.

(a) for the word “larceny” there is substituted “theft”;

(b) for “to a fine at the discretion of the Court but not exceeding £5” there is substituted “to a fine not exceeding £250”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection of Pigeons (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985. Citation.

3. This Ordinance applies in the Islands of Guernsey and Herm. Extent.
