**THE PROTECTION OF WILD BIRDS (AMENDMENT)**  
**(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1986**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1986, hereby order:-

**Amendment to Ordinance of 1950.** *Repealed by II, 2005*

1. In the Protection of Wild Birds (Alderney) Ordinance, 1950 –

(a) for section 2 (b) substitute –

“(b) A person who keeps or confines a wild bird in a cage or other receptacle is guilty of an offence under this Ordinance, unless the bird –

- (i) is kept or confined for the rendering of first aid or veterinary treatment; or
- (ii) is kept or confined for breeding and is a game bird.”;

(b) for section 3(a) substitute –

“(a) birds and the eggs and nests of birds specified in Schedule 1 and, in the months of October, November, December and January, birds but not the eggs and nests of birds specified in Schedule 2.”;

(c) for section 8(a) substitute –

“(a) A person guilty of an offence under this Ordinance is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding £100, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 months, or to both.”;

(d) for the Schedule substitute –

Rook (*Corvus Frugilegus*)  
Carrion Crow (*Corvus corone corone*)  
Hooded Crow (*Corvus corone cornix*)  
Magpie (*Pica pica*)  
Wood Pigeon (*Columba palumbus*)  
Starling (*Sturnus vulgaris*)  
House Sparrow (*Passer domesticus*)

SCHEDULE 2

Pheasant (*Phasianus colchicus*)  
Snipe (*Gallinago gallinago*)  
Woodcock (*Scolopaz rusticola*)  
Partridge (*Perdix perdix*)  
Quail (*Cotournix cotournix*)”.

**Citation.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection of Wild Birds (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1986.

**Commencement.**

3. This Ordinance comes into force on the eighth day of October, 1986.
