## THE PROTECTION OF WILD BIRDS (AMENDMENT) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1996

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 1987(a), hereby order :—

1. In section 6 of the Protection of Wild Birds (Alderney) Ordinance, 1950(b), insert the following subparagraph after paragraph (a)(ii)— **Amendment.**

“(iii) for the purposes of culling a species or type of bird specified in the certificate where in the opinion of the Committee such culling is necessary by reason of a population growth of that species or type such as to be a public nuisance.

Provided always that such culling shall be effected only by means of the taking of eggs.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection of Wild Birds (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1996.
