**The Protection of Wild Birds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, hereby order:—

1. The Protection of Wild Birds Ordinance, 1949, as amended(a), is hereby further amended as follows:— Amendments to Ordinance of 1949.

(a) immediately after section two thereof there is inserted the following additional section numbered “2A”—

“Special provisions regarding certain birds at certain times.

2A. Notwithstanding anything in this Ordinance, a person who is the holder of a current licence issued in accordance with the provisions of the Law entitled “Loi relative aux Permis de Port d’Armes de Chasse” registered

on the thirtieth day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, may, by firing with a fire-arm to which the said licence relates, kill or attempt to kill, during the period beginning on the first day of October in any year and ending on the thirty-first day of January next following any Collared Dove, Partridge, Pheasant, Snipe and Woodcock.”;

- (b) section three thereof is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor—

“Special provisions regarding gulls in the vicinity of the States Airport and States Refuse Tips. 3. Notwithstanding anything in this Ordinance, it shall be lawful for any person, thereunto specifically authorised in writing by the States Board of Administration, to kill or attempt to kill by shooting at any time any sea gull which alights on any place within the boundaries of the States Airport or within the boundaries of any Refuse Tip under the control of the States Board of Administration or is in flight over any such place.”;

- (c) in subsection (1) of section six thereof the words “twenty pounds” and “fifty pounds” are repealed and the words “one hundred pounds” and “five hundred pounds” are respectively substituted therefor;
- (d) section seven thereof is renumbered as section “7(1)” and immediately thereafter there is inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(2)”—

“(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.”;

(e) the First Schedule thereto is repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance is substituted therefor.

2. The Protection of Wild Birds (Amendment) Repeal. Ordinance, 1951(b), is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands Extent. of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou and in the territorial waters adjacent thereto.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Protection Citation. of Wild Birds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981.

5. This Ordinance and the Protection of Wild Collective Birds Ordinances, 1949 to 1974, may be cited title. together as the Protection of Wild Birds Ordinances, 1949 to 1981.
