The Provisional Ordinances, (Mode of Citation) Ordinance, 1950.

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the provisions of Article 70 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, the Provisional Ordinances of the Royal Court which were in force on the 1st day of January, 1950, became Permanent Ordinances of the States :

WHEREAS every such Ordinance is entitled " Provisional " or, where the title is in the French language, " Provisoire " :

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Legislation Committee, hereby order :—

1. The title and the short title, if any, of every Ordinance shall be deemed henceforth not to include the word " Provisional " or " Provisoire ", as the case may be.
2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 5th day of April, 1950.
