**The Psittacosis (Amendment) Ordinance,
1957**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Health, hereby order:—

1. The Psittacosis Ordinance, 1953, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in subsection (1) of section two thereof, immediately after the words “Great Britain” and immediately before the word “Jersey”, there are hereby inserted the words “Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland,”;
- (b) in section four thereof, immediately after the words “Great Britain” and immediately before the word “Jersey” where those words occur in that section, there are hereby inserted the words “Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland,”.

2. This Ordinance and the Psittacosis Ordinances, 1953 and 1954, may be cited together as the Psittacosis Ordinances, 1953 to 1957.
