**The Public Health (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1963.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Health and in exercise of the powers now vested in them under Article four of the Law entitled "Loi relative à la Santé Publique, 1934" (a), registered on the seventeenth day of March, 1934, and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. In Article VI of the Public Health Ordinance, 1936(b), as amended(c), the asterisks appearing therein and the words from and including the words "Provided that with regard to the five diseases" to the end of that Article are hereby repealed.

Application of the Law of 1934 and of the Ordinances made thereunder to Herm and Jethou.

2. (1) The Law entitled "Loi relative à la Santé Publique, 1934", registered on the seventeenth day of March, 1934, and any Ordinance made thereunder shall have effect in the Islands of Herm and Jethou in all respects as if those Islands formed part of the parish of Saint Peter Port.

(2) In the Schedule to "The Herm Laws Ordinance, 1948"^(d)—

(a) the words and figures "Loi relative à la Santé Publique, 1933, registered 17th March, 1934", in the first column of Part I thereof and the abbreviation "do." opposite those words and figures in the second column of that Part thereof are hereby repealed;

(b) the words, figures and inverted commas "The Public Health Ordinances, 1936-1942" in the first column of Part III thereof and the words "The whole of such Ordinances" opposite those words, figures and inverted commas in the second column of that Part thereof are hereby repealed.

Application of Ordinance of 1950 to Guernsey.

3. For the avoidance of doubt, it is hereby declared that the Public Health Ordinance, 1936, Amendment Ordinance, 1950, has effect, and has always had effect, in the Island of Guernsey.

Repeal.

4. Section five of the Public Health Ordinance, 1936, Amendment Ordinance, 1950, is hereby repealed.

Application and citation.

5. (1) This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

(2) This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and this Ordinance and the Public Health Ordinances, 1936 to 1950, may be cited together as the Public Health Ordinances, 1936 to 1963.
