ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 16th November 2011

Coming into force 16th November 2011

**The Public Holidays (Alderney) (Queen's Diamond Jubilee)
Ordinance, 2011**

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 16th November 2011 and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of, and paragraph (o) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 2004^a and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Public Holidays.

1. Without prejudice to the provisions of the Public Holidays (Alderney) Ordinance, 1988^b -

- (a) Monday the 28th May 2012 is not a public holiday, and
- (b) Monday the 4th June, 2012 and Tuesday the 5th June, 2012 are public holidays.

Interpretation.

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays (Alderney) (Queen's Diamond Jubilee) Ordinance, 2011 and shall come into force on the date it is approved by the States of Alderney.
