**The Public Holidays (Alderney) (Royal Wedding)**  
**Ordinance, 2011**

**THE STATES OF ALDERNEY**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2011 and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of, and paragraph (o) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 2004<sup>a</sup> and of all other powers enabling them, hereby order:-

**Public Holidays.**

1. In addition to the public holidays specified in the Public Holidays (Alderney) Ordinance, 1988<sup>b</sup>, Friday the 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2011 is a public holiday.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>c</sup> applies to the

interpretation of this Ordinance.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Citation and commencement.**

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays (Alderney) (Royal Wedding) Ordinance, 2011 and shall come into force on the date it is approved by the States of Alderney.
