## **The [Public] Holidays (Alderney) Ordinance, 1988**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the second day of March, 1988 and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 46 of, and paragraph (o) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 1987<sup>a</sup>, hereby order: –

### **[Public] holidays.**

**1.** The following are [public] holidays in Alderney –

- (a) 1<sup>st</sup> January, or, if that day is a Sunday, 2<sup>nd</sup> January,
- (b) Easter Monday,
- (c) the first Monday in May,
- (d) the last Monday in May,
- (e) the first Monday in August,
- (f) 26<sup>th</sup> December, unless that day is a Sunday,
- (g) if either 25<sup>th</sup> or 26<sup>th</sup> December is a Sunday, 27<sup>th</sup> December.
