

**The Public Holidays (Boxing Day) Ordinance, 1998**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 25th day of March, 1998<sup>1</sup>, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(1) of the Bills of Exchange (Guernsey) Law, 1958, as amended<sup>2</sup>, hereby order:-

**Public holidays in December 1998.**

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1(h) of the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1994<sup>3</sup>-

- (a) Saturday, the 26th December, 1998 shall not be a public holiday;
- (b) Monday, the 28th December, 1998 shall be a public holiday.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays (Boxing Day) Ordinance, 1998.
