

The Public Holidays (No. 2) Ordinance, 1998

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 29th day of July, 1998¹, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(1) of the Bills of Exchange (Guernsey) Law, 1958, as amended², hereby order:-

Public holidays in December 1999 and January 2000.

1. Without prejudice to the provisions of section 1 of the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1994³, the following days shall be public holidays-

- (a) Tuesday, the 28th December, 1999;
- (b) Friday, the 31st December, 1999; and
- (c) Monday, the 3rd January, 2000.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays (No. 2) Ordinance, 1998.
