The Public Markets, Slaughterhouses and Sale of Meat Regulations (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967

WHEREAS the States Board of Administration on the nineteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, in pursuance of Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative aux Marchés Publics, aux Abattoirs et à la Vente de la Viande" of the twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighteen(*a*), as amended by the Public Markets, Slaughterhouses and Sale of Meat (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962(*b*), made the Regulations set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance:

NOW THEREFORE the States, in pursuance of their Resolution of the fourteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-six, and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them by Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative aux Marchés Publics, aux Abattoirs et à la Vente de la Viande" of the twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighteen(*a*), as amended, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Regulations made by the States Board of Administration on the nineteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, and set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby approved.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Markets, Slaughterhouses and Sale of Meat Regulations (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967.

SCHEDULE

Section one

Regulations made by the States Board of Administration under Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative aux Marchés Publics, aux Abattoirs et à la Vente de la Viande" of the twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighteen, as amended by the Public Markets, Slaughterhouses and Sale of Meat (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962.

The Public Markets, Slaughterhouses and Sale of Meat Regulations approved by the Royal Court on the twenty-second day of November, nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended, are hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) Regulation 7 thereof is hereby repealed and the following Regulation is hereby substituted therefor:—

"7. Except with the written permission of the States Board of Administration, a person shall not sell or expose for sale in the Meat Market anything other than meat or meat products.";

- (b) in Regulation 15 thereof, the words "Nothing but fish, poultry, Guernsey grown fruit, Guernsey grown vegetables, Guernsey eggs and Guernsey butter may be sold or exposed for sale in the Fish Market" are hereby repealed;

- (c) immediately after Regulation 15 thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional Regulation 15A—

"15A.—Except with the written permission of the States Board of Administration, a person shall not sell or ex-

pose for sale in the Fish Market anything other than fish, poultry, Guernsey grown fruit, Guernsey grown vegetables, Guernsey eggs and Guernsey butter.”
