**The Public Records (Fees for Registration

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, hereby order:—

1. The Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Ordinance, 1960(a), is hereby amended as follows:—
