Ordinance of the States **VI** 1988

Made 27th January, 1988.

The Public Transport (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of October, 1987, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3 of the Public Transport (Guernsey) Law, 1984(a), hereby order:—

1. The Public Transport Ordinance, 1986, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(b), is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in section 5(c) thereof the words “public service omnibus service licence” are repealed and the words “public omnibus service licence” are substituted therefor;
- (b) in sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18, 26, 30, 32, 35, 38, 39, 40, 41 and 51 thereof

the words "the Committee", wherever those words occur, are repealed and the words "the Authority" are respectively substituted therefor;

- (c) in section 31 thereof—
 - (i) the words "the Committee after consultation with" are repealed;
 - (ii) the words "approved by the Committee" are repealed and the words "approved by the Authority" are substituted therefor;
- (d) in section 34(1) thereof—
 - (i) the words "the Committee after consultation with" are repealed;
 - (ii) the words "approved by the Committee" are repealed and the words "approved by the Authority" are substituted therefor;
 - (iii) the words "as the Committee may" are repealed and the words "as the Authority may" are substituted therefor;
- (e) in section 42(2) thereof the words "An officer of police or an examiner" are repealed and the words "An examiner" are substituted therefor;
- (f) in section 42(4)(b) thereof the words "the Committee" are repealed and the words "the Authority" are substituted therefor;
- (g) in section 42(5) thereof the words "The Committee or the Chief Officer of Police, as the case may be," are repealed and the words "The Chief Officer of Police" are substituted therefor;

(h) in section 53(1) thereof—

- (i) the words “the Committee in pursuance” are repealed and the words “the Authority in pursuance” are substituted therefor;
 - (ii) the words “the Committee or the Authority, as the case may be,” are repealed and the words “the Authority” are substituted therefor;
 - (iii) the words “the Committee to suspend” are repealed and the words “the Authority to suspend” are substituted therefor;
- (i) in section 53(2) thereof the words “the Committee or” are repealed;
- (j) in section 57(1) thereof in the definition of the expression “examiner” the words “the Committee” are repealed and the words “the Authority” are substituted therefor;

2. Any public service vehicle licence and any road service licence granted by the Island Police Committee under the provisions of the principal Ordinance and valid immediately before the coming into force of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have effect as though it were a public service vehicle licence or a road service licence, as the case may be, granted by the Authority under the provisions of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance and any conditions attached thereto were conditions attached under the provisions of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance. **Savings.**

3. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with the principal Ordinance. **Construction.**

Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Transport (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988.

Collective title. 5. This Ordinance and the Public Transport Ordinances, 1986 and 1987, may be cited together as the Public Transport Ordinances, 1986 to 1988.
