**The Public Transport (Fees) Ordinance, 1990**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 10th day of October, 1990(a), hereby order:—

*Provision of and increase in fees in the Public Transport Ordinance, 1986*

1. In the Public Transport Ordinance, 1986(b)—

- (a) in section 12(1) for “ten pounds” substitute “£15”;
- (b) in section 12(2) for “two pounds” substitute “£5”;
- (c) in section 12(3) for “five pounds” substitute “£7.50”;
- (d) in section 14(3) for “one pound” substitute “£5.00”;
- (e) in section 15(3) for “fifty new pence” substitute “£3.00”.
- (f) in section 42 add the following subsection—

“ (6) A fee of £10.00 shall be payable forthwith to the States Treasurer in respect of an examination performed under subsection (1) and a fee of £5.00 shall be payable forthwith in respect of an examination under subsection (2).”

*Provision of and increase in fees in the Road Traffic (Permits to Drive Public Service Vehicles) Ordinance, 1986*

2. In the Road Traffic (Permits to Drive Public Service Vehicles) Ordinance, 1986(c)—

- (a) for section 4(4) substitute—

“ (4) The fee for a driving test under subsection (3)(a)(i) shall be £12 per test period and the fee for an Island knowledge test under subsection 3(a)(ii) shall be £10, both payable in advance to the States Treasurer.”;
