**The Public Transport Licensing  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Public Transport Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1964(a), hereby order:—

1. In paragraph (e) of section thirty-two of the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966, as amended(b), the full stop at the end thereof is deleted and a colon is substituted therefor and immediately thereafter the following proviso is hereby inserted:—

“Provided that he may leave the vehicle unattended on such rank for any period in excess of fifteen minutes when the vehicle is parked

in accordance with the provisions of any order made under section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963, regulating the parking of any such vehicle for purposes other than standing or plying for hire.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Transport Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974.

Collective title.

3. This Ordinance and the Public Transport Licensing Ordinances, 1966 to 1973, may be cited together as the Public Transport Licensing Ordinances, 1966 to 1974.
