**The Public Transport Licensing (Guernsey)
Law, 1964 (Commencement) Ordinance, 1966**

THE STATES, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section one and section seven of the Public Transport Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1964(a), hereby order:—

1. The Public Transport Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1964, shall come into operation on the twenty-ninth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-six. Commencement of Law of 1964.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the last preceding section, the Passenger Transport Ordinance, 1949(b), shall continue to have effect until the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-six, subject to the following modifications, that is to say— Transitional provisions.

(a) the expression “public vehicle” shall have the same meaning as the expression “public

service vehicle" has in the Public Transport Licensing Ordinance, 1966, but shall not include a motor vehicle for the use of which a private hire omnibus licence or a private hire motor car licence would be required under the provisions of that Ordinance, and

- (b) the expression "the Authority" shall have the same meaning as that expression has in the last-mentioned Ordinance.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Transport Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1964 (Commencement) Ordinance, 1966.
