**The People's Deputies (Saint Peter Port,
Saint Peter-in-the-Wood, the Forest and
Saint Martin) Elections Ordinance, 1983**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE,
in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by
paragraph (3) of Article twenty-nine and paragraph
(3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey)
Law, 1948, as amended^(a), hereby order:—

Elections for the office of People's Deputy for
each of the electoral districts of—

- (a) Saint Peter Port left vacant by the resignation of Leonard George Corbin;
- (b) Saint Peter-in-the-Wood left vacant by the death of Helier Le Cheminant;
