

The Reform (General Election) (Sark)

Ordinance, 2010

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 23 and 25 of the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008^a, hereby order:-

Date of general election.

1. (1) The date for a general election for the purposes of electing fourteen Conseillers to replace those whose terms of office are due to expire on 14th January, 2011 shall be 8th December, 2010.

(2) The date for a further election if required in the event of an equality of votes shall be 5th January, 2011.

Tenure of Office.

2. The Conseillers elected at the general election and, in the event of an equality of votes at such election, any further election to be held under section 1(2), shall take office on 15th January 2011 and shall continue in office until 15th January, 2015.

Interpretation.

3. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Reform (General Election) (Sark) Ordinance, 2010.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on 6th October, 2010.
