

The Reform (Sark) Law, 2008 (Commencement)

Ordinance, 2008

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 21 and 69 of the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008^a, hereby order:-

Commencement of Law.

1. The Reform (Sark) Law, 2008 shall come into force as follows -
 - (a) section 8, section 9 insofar as it refers to persons appointed as Lieutenant Seneschals, and section 68, on 20th May, 2008; and
 - (b) the other provisions, on 1st September, 2008.

Effective date for new composition of Chief Pleas.

2. The date appointed for the purpose of section 21(1) of the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008, when the new composition of the Chief Pleas shall take effect, is 9th January, 2009.

Interpretation.

3. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a

reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008 (Commencement) Ordinance, 2008.
