The Refuse Disposal (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of 31st May, 1995(a), hereby order:

Amendments to Refuse Disposal Ordinance

1. In the Refuse Disposal Ordinance, 1959(b) -

(a) for the definition of "refuse dump", in section 1, substitute:

"refuse" means any article or substance (whether organic or inorganic) which requires to be disposed of because it is broken, worn out, contaminated, spoiled, or for any other reason no longer wanted.";

(b) in section 7(1),

(i) for "a refuse dump" substitute "any refuse";

(a) on Article 7 of Billet d'État No. XI of 1995.

(b) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XII, p.97; Tome XIII, p.290; Ordre en Conseil No. V of 1989; Ordonnances Nos. XXV and XXXIII of 1989; No. VII of 1991.

- (ii) for "the refuse dump" substitute "the refuse";
- (iii) for "the dump" substitute "the refuse";
- (c) in section 10, for "the refuse dump" substitute "the refuse";
- (d) in section 11,
 - (i) for "a refuse dump" substitute "any refuse";
 - (ii) for "the amount so disbursed or the sum of £2,000, whichever is the less" substitute "the amount reasonably so disbursed".

Consequential repeal

2. Section 1(a) of the Refuse Disposal (Amendment) Ordinance, 1991(c) is repealed.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Refuse Disposal (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995.
