## **The Rent Control Ordinance, 1958**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of February, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Rent Control (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1956, hereby order:—

1. The amount of the Cadastre rateable value referred to in section one of the Rent Control (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1956, as the amount which determines that a dwelling-house with a Cadastre rateable value in excess of that amount and which is, in the opinion of the Cadastre Committee, in a reasonable state of repair shall cease to be a controlled dwelling, shall, on and after the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, be thirty-eight pounds.
2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
