The Rent Control Ordinance, 1963

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Rent Control (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1956(a), hereby order:—

1. The amount of the Cadastre rateable value referred to in section one of the Rent Control (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1956, as amended, as the amount which determines that a dwelling-house with a Cadastre rateable value in excess of that amount and which is, in the opinion of the Cadastre Committee, in a reasonable state of repair shall cease

Certain dwelling-houses to cease to be controlled dwellings.

to be a controlled dwelling, shall, on and after the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, be twenty-five pounds.

- Repeal. 2. The Rent Control Ordinance, 1958(b), is hereby repealed.
- Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rent Control Ordinance, 1963.
- Commence-
ment. 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
