

Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

The Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1972

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of section eight of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the fourteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Amendment to
Ordinance of
1968

1. The Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Sark) Ordinance, 1968, is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) section four thereof is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:-

“4. Except as otherwise directed in an emergency by the Constable, a person being in charge of a horse-drawn vehicle shall not drive or attempt to drive that horse-drawn vehicle or cause or permit it to remain on the jetty at La Maseline Harbour otherwise than in compliance with such directions as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the Road Traffic Committee by Order.”;

(b) in paragraph (a) of section seventeen thereof immediately after the word “Ordinance” there are hereby inserted the words “or any Order made thereunder or fails to comply with any direction given by the Constable”.

Citation

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1972.

Commencement

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
