Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

The Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment)  
(Sark) Ordinance, 1976

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of section eight of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Amendment to Ordinance of 1968.

1. Subsection (4) of section three of the Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Sark) Ordinance, 1968, is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor:-

"(4) The number of passengers which a horse-drawn vehicle is permitted to carry under the provisions of subsection (1) or subsection (2) of this section may be increased to the extent that any child who appears to the person in charge of that vehicle to be under the age of three years may not be counted as a passenger and every two children who appear to the said person to be over the age of three years but under the age of six years may be counted as being equivalent to one passenger so however that the total number of passengers over the age of three years carried in a horse-drawn vehicle at any one time shall not exceed by more than one the number of passengers that vehicle is permitted to carry under the provisions of the said subsection (1) or the said subsection (2), as the case may be."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1976.

commencement.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the thirteenth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
