Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

The Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment) (Sark)  
Ordinance, 1980

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of section eight of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the third day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. Section nine of the Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Sark) Ordinance, 1968, is hereby re-numbered as subsection (1) of section nine thereof and immediately thereafter there is hereby inserted the following additional subsection numbered "(2)" -

"(2) A person being in charge of a horse-drawn vehicle which is used for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward shall not, prior to nine o'clock in the forenoon on any day, be offered for such use either by standing or plying for hire."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1980.
