

ORDINANCE OF THE CHIEF PLEAS

ENTITLED

The Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 2008

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 26th day of March, 2008, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 8 of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951^a, as amended, hereby order:-

Use of horse-drawn vehicles on Sundays.

1. Subject to the same restrictions and conditions that govern the use of horse-drawn vehicles during the rest of the week, it shall be lawful to drive a horse-drawn vehicle on or along any of the public roads, and to carry passengers in such a vehicle, on a Sunday.

Amendment of the 1968 Ordinance.

2. Consequently section 5 ("Restriction on use of horse-drawn vehicles on Sundays") of the Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Sark) Ordinance, 1968 (as amended) is repealed.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 2008.
