Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

entitled

The Road Traffic (Tractors and Invalid Carriages)
(Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1983

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of section eight of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twentieth day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order :-

1. The Road Traffic (Tractors and Invalid Carriages) (Sark) Ordinance, 1967, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section one thereof is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor -

"(a) of a roller or other road repairing machine, a mobile crane or a fork lift truck by a servant or agent of the Chief Pleas;"

(b) immediately after section two thereof there is inserted the following marginal note and additional section numbered "2A" -

"Amount of
licence tax.

2A.(1) There shall be chargeable in respect of the grant or renewal of a tractor driving licence under the provisions of subsection (2) or subsection (4) of the last preceding section, as the case may be, the tax specified in subsection (3) or subsection

(4) of this section, as the case may be.

(2) The tax chargeable under the provisions of the last preceding subsection shall be paid to the Constable upon the grant or renewal of a tractor driving licence under the provisions of subsection (2) or subsection (4) of the last preceding subsection, as the case may be.

(3) Subject to the provisions of the next succeeding subsection, the tax chargeable under the provisions of this section in respect of the grant or renewal of a tractor driving licence shall be such amount not exceeding five pounds as may be prescribed.

(4) In the case where an application for the grant of a tractor driving licence is made on or after the first day of July in any year the tax chargeable under the provisions of this section in respect of such grant shall be such amount not exceeding two pounds and fifty new pence as may be prescribed.";

(c) the definition of the expression "tractor" in

subsection (1) of section nineteen thereof
is repealed and the following definition
is substituted therefor -

' "tractor" has the meaning assigned to it
by subsection (1) of section twenty of
the Tractors (Sark) Law, 1974, and
includes a tractor to which there is
attached a trailer. '.
