THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of the provisions of section 8(1) of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Ordinance of

1. In the Road Traffic (Tractors and Invalid Carriages) (Sark) Ordinance, 1967, as amended -

1967.

(a) in section 10(1) after "as the case may be" insert "and two lamps each showing to the rear a red light visible from a reasonable distance behind and one of which is placed on the right rear and the other on the left rear of the tractor or invalid carriage, as the case may be";

(b) in section 10(2) after "ahead" insert "and a lamp showing to the rear a red light visible from a reasonable distance behind".

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Traffic (Tractors and Invalid Carriages) (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1988.
