The Special Constabulary (Amendment) (No. 2)

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 66(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments to Ordinance

1. (1) In section 6A(1) of the Special Constabulary Ordinance, 1950(b) after "the oath prescribed in subsection (3)" insert "before the Royal Court sitting as an Ordinary Court".

(2) In section 6A(2)(a) thereof-

(a) in subparagraph (i), for "employed" substitute "nominated";

(b) in subparagraph (ii), for "employed" substitute "nominated" and for "employment" substitute "deployment";

- (c) in subparagraph (iv), for "employed" substitute "nominated" and for "and authorised in that behalf" substitute "or".
