The Special Constabulary (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 25th day of April, 1985, hereby order:—

1. The Special Constabulary Ordinance, 1950, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) in section 2 thereof the words “the Island of Guernsey” are repealed and the words “the Islands of Guernsey and Herm” are substituted therefor;

(b) immediately after section 13 thereof there is inserted the following additional section numbered “13A”—

“Interpreta-
tion.

13A. In this Ordinance the expression “the Island of Guernsey” includes the Island of Herm and the expression “this Island” shall be construed accordingly.”.

Extent. 2. This Ordinance, the Special Constabulary Ordinance, 1950 and the Special Constabulary (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973, shall extend to the Island of Herm.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Special Constabulary (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985.

Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the Special Constabulary Ordinances, 1950 and 1973, may be cited together as the Special Constabulary Ordinances, 1950 to 1985.
