THE SPEED TRIALS (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1994

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 6th day of April 1994, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 46 of and paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 to the Government of Alderney Law, 1987(a) hereby order:—

1. The road from Whitegates to Mannez Lighthouse shall be closed between 0800 and 1830 hours on Friday 16th September 1994 and the road at Tourgis Hill shall be closed between 0900 and 1800 hours on Saturday 17th September 1994 in each case to all vehicular traffic except under and in accordance with the specific permission in writing of the States Public Works Committee and for drivers of vehicles taking part in, or involved in the organisation of, any trial of speed held with the written consent of, and under such conditions (whether with regard to the safeguarding of people taking part in the trial and of other people, or otherwise) as are imposed by the States Public Works Committee.

**Closure of roads

Exemption from speed limit and noise restrictions.

2. Regulations 10 and 13 of the Traffic Regulations, 1986 as amended, do not apply to the driver of a vehicle taking part in these trials of speed in accordance with those conditions.

Offence.

3. A person who uses a motor vehicle on the said roads on Friday 16th September 1994 or as the case may be on Saturday 17th September 1994, otherwise than in accordance with section 1 of this Ordinance, and any conditions imposed by the States Public Works Committee as mentioned therein, is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the Alderney Uniform Scale.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Speed Trials (Alderney) Ordinance, 1994.
