THE SPEED TRIALS (ALDERNEY)
ORDINANCE, 2000

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 12th day of April 2000, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 46 of and paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 to The Government of Alderney Law, 1987(a) hereby order:—

1. The road from Tourgis Hill shall be closed between 0900 and 1800 hours on Friday 15th September and Saturday 16th September, 2000 to all vehicular traffic except under and in accordance with the conditions of the specific permission in writing of the States General Services Committee and for drivers of vehicles taking part in, or involved in the organisation of, any trial of speed held with the written consent of, and under and in accordance with such conditions (whether with regard to the safeguarding of people taking part in the trial and of other people, or otherwise) as are imposed by the States General Services Committee.

Exemption from speed limit and noise restrictions.

2. Regulations 10 and 13 of The Traffic Regulations, 1986, as amended, do not apply to the driver of a vehicle taking part in any such trials of speed in accordance with the said conditions.

Offence.

3. A person who uses a motor vehicle on the said roads on Friday 15th September, 2000 or as the case may be on Saturday 16th September, 2000, otherwise than in accordance with section 1 of this Ordinance, and any conditions imposed by the States General Services Committee as mentioned therein, is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the Alderney Uniform Scale.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as The Speed Trials (Alderney) Ordinance, 2000.
