THE SPEED TRIALS (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 2004

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 22nd day of June 2004, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 46 of and paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 to The Government of Alderney Law, 1987(a) hereby order:—

1. The road from Whitegates to Mannez Lighthouse may be closed by the States General Services Committee between 0800 and 1800 hours on Friday 17th September 2004 and the road at Tourgis Hill may be closed by the States General Services Committee between 0800 and 1800 hours on Saturday 18th September 2004 in each case to all vehicular traffic except under and in accordance with the specific permission in writing of the States General Services Committee and for drivers of vehicles taking part in, or involved in the organisation of, any trial of speed held with the written consent of, and under such conditions (whether with regard to the safeguarding of people taking part in the trial and of other people, or otherwise) as are imposed by the States General Services Committee.

**Closure of roads

2. A notice confirming the closure of the said roads by the States General Services Committee shall be published in the Alderney Official Gazette at least five days prior to 17th September 2004.

3. Regulations 10 and 13 of The Traffic Regulations, 1986, as amended, do not apply to the driver of a vehicle taking part in these trials of speed in accordance with those conditions.

Offence.

4. A person who uses a motor vehicle on the said roads on Friday 17th September 2004 or as the case may be on Saturday 18th September 2004, otherwise than in accordance with section 1 of this Ordinance, and any conditions imposed by the States General Services Committee as mentioned therein, is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the Alderney Uniform Scale provided that they have been closed by the States General Services Committee under the provisions of section 1.

Citation.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Speed Trials (Alderney) Ordinance, 2004".
