Ordinance of the States. **II**
1954

Made 20th January, 1954.

Coming into Operation ... 1st February, 1954.

**The St. Peter Port Harbour (Speed Limit)
Ordinance, 1954.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration, hereby order:—

1. The Master or Pilot of a vessel shall not cause or permit that vessel to proceed ahead or astern or to manoeuvre within the prohibited zone at a speed in excess of four knots.

2. A Master or Pilot who contravenes any of the provisions of the last preceding section shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds.

3. In this Ordinance the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:—

“Master” means the person for the time being in charge of a vessel;

“prohibited zone” means that area of the harbour of Saint Peter Port west of a line drawn from the north-western corner of the New Jetty to the western extremity of the Castle Bridge;

“vessel” means anything made for the conveyance by water of human beings or of property.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st day of February, 1954.
