Ordinance of the States **XI**

1972

Made 29th March, 1972.
Coming into Operation ... 1st April, 1972.

The States Supervisor (Transfer of Functions) (No. 1) Ordinance, 1972

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States (Transfer of Functions) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. (1) The powers and functions formerly vested in the States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States, by whatever name that office was described, under or by virtue of the provisions of the Laws set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance and now vested in the States Supervisor, are hereby transferred to and vested in:—

Transfer of certain powers and functions to States Treasurer and Board of Administration.

- (a) the States Treasurer in the case of the Laws set out in Part I of the said Schedule;
- (b) the States Board of Administration in the case of the Law set out in Part II of the said Schedule.

(2) In addition to the powers and functions transferred and vested under the provisions of the

last preceding subsection there are also hereby so transferred and vested all rights and liabilities enjoyed by, or incumbent on, the States Supervisor in, or as a result of, the exercise of those powers and functions.

Savings.

2. (1) Nothing done by, or in relation to, the States Supervisor under or as a consequence of the powers or functions transferred under the provisions of subsection (1) of the last preceding section before the coming into force of this Ordinance shall be invalidated by the coming into force thereof.

(2) Anything in the process of being done under any of the provisions referred to in section one of this Ordinance by, or in relation to, the States Supervisor at the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, whether by way of legal proceedings or otherwise, may be continued by, or in relation to, the States Treasurer or the States Board of Administration, as the case may be.

Amend-
ments.

3. The Laws set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby amended to the extent set out in the second column of that Schedule.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Supervisor (Transfer of Functions) (No. 1) Ordinance, 1972.

Commence-
ment.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.

Laws vesting powers and functions transferred	Extent of amendment
Section thirteen of the Currency Offences (Guernsey) Law, 1950(e).	In the proviso to subsection (1) of section thirteen the words "States Supervisor" are hereby repealed and the words "States Treasurer" are hereby substituted therefor.
Section twenty-five of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951 (f).	In section twenty-five the words "Treasurer of the Guernsey States" are hereby repealed and the words "States Treasurer of Guernsey" are hereby substituted therefor.
Subsection (9) of section seven and subsection (1) of section eight of and the Schedule to the Clearance of Ruins (Guernsey) Law, 1957(g).	In subsection (9) of section seven, in subsection (1) of section eight and in the Schedule the words "Treasurer of the States" are hereby repealed and the words "States Treasurer" are hereby substituted therefor.

Article I of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux ventes publiques à l'encan" registered on the twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and fourteen(h).	In Article I the words "Trésorier des Etats" where those words occur are hereby repealed and the words "Conseil Administratif des Etats" are hereby substituted therefor.
