## **The States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 1972**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order: –

### **Transfer of powers and functions.**

1. (1) The powers and functions vested in the States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States, by whatever name that office is described, under or by virtue of the provisions of any Ordinance in force immediately prior to the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance are hereby transferred to and vested in the chief executive officer of the States Advisory and Finance Council (hereinafter referred to as "**the States Supervisor**").

(2) In addition to the powers and functions transferred and vested under the provisions of the last preceding subsection there are also hereby so transferred and vested all rights and liabilities enjoyed by, or incumbent on, the States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States in, or as a result of, the exercise of those powers or functions.

### **NOTE**

*In accordance with the provisions of the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, respectively section 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 1(a) and section 3, with effect from 6th May, 2004, the States Advisory and Finance Committee and the States Supervisor were replaced by the Policy Council and the Chief Executive of the States of Guernsey, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 4 of the 2003 Ordinance; and the functions, rights and liabilities of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and of its President arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance have been transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Policy Council and its Minister by the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 1(a), with effect from 6th May, 2004. In accordance with the provisions of the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 10(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016, the Policy Council has since been replaced by the Policy & Resources Committee; and the functions, rights and liabilities of the Policy Council and of its Minister or Deputy Minister arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance were transferred to and vested*

*in, respectively, the Policy & Resources Committee and its President or Vice-President by the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 10(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 3 of the 2016 Ordinance.*

**Savings.**

2. (1) Nothing done by, or in relation to, the States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States under or as a consequence of the powers or functions transferred under the provisions of subsection (1) of the last preceding section before the coming into force of this Ordinance shall be invalidated by the coming into force thereof.

(2) Anything in process of being done under any of the provisions referred to in subsection (1) of the last preceding section by, or in relation to, the States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States at the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, whether by way of legal proceedings or otherwise, may be continued by, or in relation to, the States Supervisor.

**Change of references.**

3. Any reference in any Ordinance in force immediately prior to the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance to any of the following expressions, that is to say –

"        the States Supervisor  
          the Treasurer of the States  
          le Supérieur des États  
          le Supérieur et Trésorier des États  
          le Supérieur de la Chaussée et Trésorier des États  
          le Supérieur de la Chaussée  
          le Trésorier des États        "

shall be construed as a reference to the States Supervisor.

**Citation.**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Supervisor and Treasurer of the States (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 1972.

**Commencement.**

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
