The States Water Supply (Maximum Rates) Ordinance, 1958

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and in pursuance of Articles fourteen and seventeen of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended, and of a Resolution of the States of the thirtieth day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The maximum annual rate referred to in paragraph (a) of Article fourteen of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile"

registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") for the supply of water to any property for domestic use shall be fifteen pounds sixteen shillings and eight pence per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied.

2. The maximum annual rate referred to in paragraph (b) of Article fourteen of the Law for each ordinary bath fixed in any property shall be thirteen shillings and four pence.

3. The maximum rate referred to in paragraph (b) of Article seventeen of the Law for the supply of water for other than domestic purposes shall be three shillings and eight pence per thousand gallons.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-sixth day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
