**The States Water Supply (Maximum Rates) Ordinance, 1971**

—1971)

THE STATES, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Articles fourteen and seventeen of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby order:—

1. The maximum annual rate referred to in paragraph (a) of Article fourteen of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") for the supply of water to any property for domestic use shall be sixteen pounds per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied.

2. The maximum rate referred to in paragraph (b) of Article seventeen of the Law for the supply of water for other than domestic purposes shall be four new pence per cubic metre.

Repeal.

3. The States Water Supply (Maximum Rates) Ordinance, 1958(b), is hereby repealed.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Maximum Rates) Ordinance, 1971.
