Made 17th December, 1975.
Coming into Operation ... 1st January, 1976.

The States Water Supply (Maximum Rates) Ordinance, 1975

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the seventeenth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Articles fourteen and seventeen of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended^(a), hereby order:—

1. The maximum annual rate referred to in paragraph (a) of Article fourteen of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") for the supply of water to any property for domestic use shall be sixty-eight Water for domestic purposes.

pounds per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied.

Water for other than domestic purposes.

2. The maximum rate referred to in paragraph (b) of Article seventeen of the Law for the supply of water for other than domestic purposes shall be seventeen new pence per cubic metre.

Repeal.

3. The States Water Supply (Maximum Rates) Ordinance, 1974(b), is hereby repealed.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Maximum Rates) Ordinance, 1975.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
