**THE STATES WATER SUPPLY (PREVENTION OF  
POLLUTION) (ALDERNEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE,  
1981**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty-one and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Alderney) Law, 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby order:-

**Amendment to Ordinance of 1973.**

1. The definition of the expressions "building" and "domestic building" in subsection (1) of section one of the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1973, as amended, (b) are hereby repealed and the following definitions are hereby respectively substituted therefor:-

"building" includes any well, bore hole, cistern, cesspit, cellar or other excavation below surface levels whether containing structure or not but does not include any wall or permanent hoarding;

"domestic building" has the meaning assigned to it by paragraph (1) of Regulation 1 of the Building (Alderney) Regulations, 1978".

**Citation.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinances, 1981.

**Collective title.**

2. This Ordinance and the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Alderney) Ordinances, 1973 and 1975, may be cited together as the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Alderney) Ordinances, 1973 to 1981.
