**The States Water Supply (Prevention of
Pollution) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twelfth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Guernsey) Law, 1965(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The definition of the expression “the controlled area” in subsection (1) of section one of the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) Ordinance, 1966, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(b), is hereby repealed and the following definition is hereby substituted therefor—

“the controlled area” means the area of the Island within the continuous green line

marked on a map which for the purpose of identification was signed by the Bailiff on the twenty-third day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and lodged at the Greffe;”.

Repeal.

2. The States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973, is hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the States Water Supply (Prevention of Pollution) Ordinances, 1966 and 1977.
