ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 5th June, 1974
Coming into force 5th June, 1974

THE STATES WATER SUPPLY (RATES OF CHARGE)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1974

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the third day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section fourteen of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (a), hereby order:-

Water according to rateable value for domestic purposes.

1. The annual rate referred to in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section fourteen of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") for the supply of water to any property for domestic use shall be as follows:-

- (a) until and including Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, £36 per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied;
- (b) from and including the day next following Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, £47 per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied.

Water for baths.

2. The annual rate referred to in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section fourteen of the Law for each ordinary bath fixed in any property shall be as follows:-

- (a) until and including Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, £1;
- (b) from and including the day next following Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, £1.30.
