ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 5th March, 1980
Coming into force 26th March, 1980

THE STATES WATER SUPPLY (RATES OF CHARGE)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1980

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution on the fifth day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section fourteen of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (a), hereby order:-

Water according to rateable value for domestic purposes.

1. The annual rate referred to in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section fourteen of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") for the supply of water to any property for domestic use shall be, from and including the day next following Lady Day, nineteen hundred and eighty, £104 per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied.

Water for baths.

2. The annual rate referred to in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section fourteen of the Law for each ordinary bath fixed in any property shall be, from and including the day next following Lady Day, nineteen hundred and eighty, £3.00.

Water by measure for domestic use.

3. The rate referred to in paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section fourteen of the Law for the supply of water by measure to any property for domestic use shall be, from and including the day next following Lady Day, nineteen hundred and eighty, £1.10 per thousand gallons.

Water by measure for other than domestic purposes.

4. The rate referred to in paragraph (b) of sub-section (2) of section fourteen of the Law for the supply of water by measure for other than domestic purposes shall be, from and including the day next following Lady Day, nineteen hundred and eighty, £1.10 per thousand gallons.

Repeals.

5. The States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1977, is hereby repealed.

Citation.

6. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1980.

Commencement.

7. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-sixth day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty.
